Re: Amounts Received (2000 - 2008): \$61.3 Million?

Further to my previous letters, I am writing to you as a concerned member of the public. This is an open letter. I have posted it at www.fair-questions.com. You are welcome to comment.

As I mentioned in my letter of 9 November 2009, my calculations based on your annual reports suggest to me that between 2000 and 2008, the David Suzuki Foundation had revenues of \$53,424,396.

According to my calculations based on information that is publicly available at the web-site of Revenue Canada, between 2000 and 2008 the David Suzuki Foundation has had revenues of \$61,334,599. Is this correct? On the basis of these calculations, it appears to me that \$32,231,419 (53 percent) was from tax-receipted donations, \$4,856,611 (8 percent) was from other registered charities, and \$22,575,138 (27 percent) was from other gifts and other revenues. A total of \$1,681,431 (3 percent) was from fees, interest and dividends, rental income, and income from the sale of goods and services. (Page 3).

As far as I can tell, a total of \$27,431,749 - 35 percent of amounts received - was from other registered charities and other sources. Where did these funds originate?

U.S. tax returns and information from Capital Research (attached) suggests to me that since 2000, American foundations have granted about \$US 10 million to the David Suzuki Foundation. In addition, three of these American foundation have granted at least \$43.7 million to Tides Canada Foundation which re-grants to the David Suzuki Foundation and others. Of the \$27.4 million that the David Suzuki Foundation has received since 2000 from other charities and other sources, how much originated from American sources?


Lastly, why is there is an apparent discrepancy of \$6,702,024 between the total amounts received according to what is reported in annual reports of the David Suzuki Foundation, and what is reported at Revenue Canada's web-site for the period from 2000 - 2008? Why does the amount reported in the David Suzuki Foundation's annual report match the figure reported at Revenue Canada's web-site for 2005, but not for other years?


