Subject: Vision Vancouver Campaign Finance & Mayor Robertson's 2010 Meeting with the Rockefeller Brothers

Mayor Robertson,

Earlier this year, we met briefly in the lobby of the CBC. At that time, you kindly agreed to allow me a brief meeting with you. Now that Vision Vancouver has released its campaign finance disclosure statements and I have taken a look at them, I would like to inquire as to whether it would be possible to have that appointment to meet with you, as your schedule permits.

As before, I would like to inquire about the origins of your campaign finance that was contributed from Interdependent Investments Ltd, Renewal Partners, Strategic Communications, Convergence Communications and Communicopia.

I would also like to inquire about the purpose of your meeting with Mr. Michael Northrop of the Rockefeller Brothers Fund Inc., in New York, in April of 2010. Earlier this year, it came to light that for many years, the Rockefeller Brothers have been co-ordinating a \$7 million dollar "Tar Sands campaign" that would choke off Canada's opportunities to export oil to Asia by stopping the Northern Gateway pipeline and by blocking tanker traffic on the coast of B.C. Part of

the Rockefeller Brothers strategy is to involve "opinion leaders" and enroll "key decision makers." The point person on the Rockefeller Brothers "Tar Sands" campaign is Mr. Northorp, the same person that you and Mr. Mike Magee met with on your trip to New York, at taxpayers expense.

I notice that Mr. Northorp also plays or played for many years, a key role in the U.S. Presidential Climate Action Project and that the Rockefeller Brothers and the Rockefeller Family Foundation have granted at least \$3 million for 350.org and its precursor, 1Sky.

In light of the above and your recent stance against an increase in oil tanker traffic in the Vancouver area, I believe its fair to inquire as to whether you and/or Mr. Magee are involved in any way with the projects of the Rockefeller Brothers Fund such as the "Tar Sands" campaign of the Rockefeller Brothers Fund, the U.S. Presidential Climate Action Project or 350.org, the campaign led by Bill McKibben?

In closing, I would like to make clear that I am not part of any industry, any campaign or any political party. I am writing to you as a member of the public. I am also a contributor to The Financial Post and write a blog: www.fair-questions.com.
