STATEMENT OF ACTIVITIES AND BUDGET

Theanon Charitable Foundation has been incorporated to act as a public foundation. Its purpose is to receive gifts from donors and pass them through to "qualified donees". The name "Theanon" is a contraction of the words "the anonymous". Its primary function will be to protect the anonymity of donors who will primarily be clients of Douglas, Symes and Brissenden who do not want the recipient charity to know who is making the charitable gift. Theanon will be able to issue the receipt to the donor and retain confidentiality while flowing the money through to the intended recipient charity.

Theanon does not have any specific budget at this point in time and has no present intentions of hiring staff. The volume of its giving will depend on the amount of money which people choose to channel through this foundation.
